



THE NEW ROOM, WHICH DATES BACK TO 1739, IS THE OLDEST METHODIST BUILDING IN THE WORLD AND REMAINS A PLACE OF WORSHIP AND PILGRIMAGE FOR CHRISTIANS FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD.

The New Room, also known as John Wesley's Chapel, was his first headquarters and it is from here that he began to travel the length and breadth of the country "preaching the glad tidings of salvation." Learn how this historic building came to be based here in Bristol and the active role it continues to play in the city today.



#### DID YOU KNOW...?

The clock in the chapel was given to the New Room by John Wesley. He gave its twin to John Street Church in New York City; the oldest Methodist site in the USA.



IN ADDITION TO THE CHAPEL, THERE ARE PREACHERS' ROOMS UPSTAIRS WHICH NOW ACCOMMODATE THE MUSEUM.

Through a number of John Wesley's own personal items, along with pictures, books and other artefacts, the museum helps to tell the story of his life and how the Methodist church came to be founded on his work and ideas.

There is also a shop upstairs which stocks a wide range of merchandise including souvenirs unique to the New Room.

You are invited to come and visit the New Room to experience its religious, cultural and historical significance.





#### CHARLES WESLEY'S HOUSE IN BRISTOL

Charles lived at the house, which is located just a short distance from the New Room, with his wife and family from 1766-1771.

It was whilst in Bristol that he wrote some of the 9000 hymns that he composed during his lifetime, many of which are still sung today by Christians all over

the world. It has been restored to how it would have looked when Charles lived there, including the parlour, music room and kitchen. The rear garden is also laid out in an 18th century style and includes a unique sundial and medicinal herbs.
